Race 1 – Sat 27th October



It was cloudy and it was wet and it was slippery. All the things the sports governing body say that are too perilous for young drivers to race on slick tyres. Having seen the world's finest Formula Ford boys struggle for grip, one might have been forgiven for raising some concern. Ok, our young drivers went out on Dunlop wet tyres and didn't they do well!!

The title favourite Charles Ladell was on pole and alongside him was Ben Wilcox with Aiden Moffat lining up next with Alfonso Skriczka. On the third row, Jack Mitchell and James Ross, then Rory Collingbourne, James Bourne, Alex Reed and finally our young female driver Natasha Hussain.



As the red lights went out, all ten Fiesta Junior STs went off towards Paddock for the first time. Timid they were not. It was Ross who arguably made the best of starts on the wet track and was fourth into Paddock as Ladell led with Moffat inside of Wilcox. Ross emerged fifth as Mitchell clung to a tight line. Up to Druids and Ladell had the gap as again Moffat and Wilcox rounded the bend almost as one. It was slippery and into Graham Hill Ross had some swift corrections to steering as he fish tailed through but his diminished speed saw Skriczka get by along Cooper straight. Clearways and clear contact from Mitchell on Wilcox who saw the latter spin outside the track but fortunately onto tarmac run-off but he was again involved as he returned to the track and contacted Alex Reed's nearside. End of the first lap of seventeen and leader Ladell crossed the line well ahead of Moffat in 2nd place then Skriczka and Ross in 3rd and 4th. Rory Collingbourne was showing well in the hunt as he went over in 5th ahead of Mitchell. A larger spread now between the cars. A pitted Mitchell regained the track but Reed was stopped in the pitlane with his driver door open. No other dramas for the cars and a good win at the chequered flag for Charles Ladell with Aiden Moffat 2nd and Alfonso Skriczka 3rd.

Race 2



The last race of the season and Charles Ladell the Poleman lined up with Aiden Moffat and behind them the cars of Alfonso Skriczka, James Ross, then Ben Wilcox and Rory Collingbourne, then James Bourne, Natasha Hussain, and finally Jack Mitchell and Alex Reed. This race would be shortened owing to an incident between Wilcox and Reed which resulted in a shunt onto the tyres inside on the exit from Druids for the former.

Red lights off and a slow start from Skriczka as Ross got up to 3rd and Natasha Hussain into 6th as the grid took Paddock. Wilcox went wide and onto the gravel but kept it going on the wet grainy surface to re-join in last spot. In watching this I missed Moffat taking the lead from Ladell as they ended the lap with Ross 3rd and in 4th Skriczka. The field was tighter bunched than the previous race, perhaps owing to the drier track which was officially described as damp. Moffat looked both competent and good as he led and his race lines very tidy. I am sure that Ladell was still trying hard to win as it is his nature to win. Good to see Mitchell up and now going well as he looked to take 4th from Skriczka as the cars raced along Cooper straight and into Surtees sensibly



allowing the red ST to keep the racing line and tuck in behind in his 5th spot. Moffat was now being relentlessly chased by Ladell and Ross. Good stuff. The first part came to an end as into Druids and initial contact between Hussain and Wilcox seemed to have had no lasting issues then, however on the run down the hill from the exit, Reed inside made contact with the offside rear of Wilcox which resulted in a heavy tyre wall impact for Wilcox. Race over.

The re-start went off and Ross bogged down and there was some contact between him and Reed as they both drove towards Paddock. Moffat again led and looked comfortable with Ladell still close up and personal behind his friend. A good drive by Ross to recover a third place and as the chequered flag came out a delighted and well deserved win for Aiden Moffat from Charles Ladell and James Ross.


